Car Park next to St Dunstan's Church (Kings Heath Car Park)

Just over 12 months ago, we had to make the decision to change the way the car park was operated.

We had many parking issues – primarily the safety of pedestrians due to the sheer volume of cars not parked in spaces forcing pedestrians to walk into the road, the lack of space for parishioners to park when coming to Mass and the safety of staff who were facing increasing problems including abuse from people who did not want to pay to park.

We thank you for your continued patience as we all get used to the system and we ask that you all adhere to the parking regulations.

As a reminder:

- Please park in designated car parking spaces only.
- When coming to Mass of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, you must enter your full registration into the tablet.
- The tablets are switched on approximately 30 minutes before Mass. If you visit church outside of these times, you will need to pay for parking.
- Parking for Mass on Sunday morning is free without the need to enter your registration number into the tablet.
- Taxis or families dropping off or picking up will have a 10-minute grace period.
